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Передмова

Навчально-репертуарний посібник «Грає інструментальний ансамбль “Експромт”» – результат багаторічної творчості, концертної і педагогічної діяльності інституту мистецтв Східноєвропейського національного університету імені Лесі Українки. Автор збірки – кандидат мистецтвознавства, доцент П. Й. Шиманський – представляє оригінальний практичний досвід джазових аранжувань творчого репертуару баяністів для інструментальних ансамблів різних складів.

Мета посібника – представити неординарність реєстрових, тембрових, технічних можливостей баянного репертуару як мотивацію до виявлення його оркестральних можливостей засобами різноманітних інструментальних поєднань. Нові звучання, відкриті баяном у транскрипціях шедеврів світової класики, джазу тощо автор збірки екстраполює на оригінальні виразово-темброві звукові поєднання камерного ансамблю «Експромт».

Завданням збагачення репертуару ансамблю студентів інституту мистецтв й оволодіння особливостями стилістики, структури, ритмо-інтонаційного та гармонічного словника джазу зумовлено вибір творів навчально-репертуарного посібника «Грає інструментальний ансамбль “Експромт”». Оригінальністю відзначається вільний «фольклорно-класичний» тембровий синтез ансамблю, у якому ведучу функцію виконує баян, активно кореспондуючи з іншими інструментами. Мішаний склад ансамблю «Експромт» уключає дві скрипки, флейту, баян, гітару, кобзовий контрабас, ударні. Співвідношення між інструментальними партіями спирається на діалогічну природу джазової імпровізації, у якій кожен інструмент має стабільні, остинатні й сольні виступи.

Твори, що ввійшли до навчально-репертуарного посібника, презентують творчість видатних баяністів сучасності В. Власова та Д. Крамера в аранжуванні доцентів і викладачів інституту мистецтв П. Шиманського й

А. Кухтюка, а саме: «Старий мерседес», «Бассо остінато» В. Власова і «Фантазія на тему “В лесу родилась елочка”» Д. Крамера/ В. Біщука (аранжування П. Шиманського), «Боса нова» В. Власова (аранжування А. Кухтюка).

Атмосферу яскравого музичного спілкування презентують обрані до змісту цього навчально-репертуарного посібника твори. Удало реалізована авторська ідея видання, яка стосується незапрограмованої реакції на звучання творів у незвичному тембровому оформленні. Вона розрахована під час концерту на створення ситуації «на стику» очікуваного й несподіваного, «впізнавання» відомого та «пізнання» нового. У популярних у баянному й фортепіанному репертуарі творах В. Власова та Д. Крамера, які відразу впізнаються на слух, відкриваються нові резерви та грані акустичної просторовості в процесі докладного опрацювання зі студентами тембрової логіки авторських аранжувань П. Шиманського й А. Кухтюка для інструментального ансамблю. Отже, практичне використання посібника допоможе студентам-виконавцям через рішення навчальних і художньо-естетичних завдань придбати й удосконалити виконавську майстерність та здобути сценічні навички музичного спілкування зі слухачем.

Навчально-репертуарний посібник «Грає інструментальний ансамбль “Експромт”» призначений для студентів, які вивчають курс «Інструментальний ансамбль», і студентів ОКР «Бакалавр» на базі молодшого спеціаліста (I–II курс) та на базі загальноосвітньої школи (II, III, IV курси). Також посібник може бути рекомендований для студентів і викладачів вищих навчальних закладів I–IV рівнів акредитації, професійним та аматорськими інструментальним колективам для практичного використання, а також усім, хто цікавиться подальшими перспективами розвитку репертуару у сфері ансамблевого виконавства.
