

2. SUMMARY OF THE COURSE:

Sociology as a science and its place in the humanities and social science. The main functions of sociology. Background of sociology. The place and role of social research in the knowledge of social phenomena. Methods of collecting primary data. The social structure of society. Sociology of work and industrial relations. Sociology of family life and leisure. Sociology of education and culture. Sociology of personality.

Topic 2. The institutional framework of international information relations

The ideology of the legal regulation of the international information field. The system and structure of international information law. International agreements on cross-border exchange of information, information products and services.

Topic 3. International information policy

History, theory and practice of international politics. The main provisions of international politics. Dynamics of International Programs. International information policy in the XXI century. Specificity and substantive provisions of a regional information policy (European regional

information policy, information policy in the region of Latin America and the Caribbean, information policy, Asia-Pacific, African information policy and information policy in the region of Western Asia). Comparative analysis of national information policy concepts of the world.

Topic 4. Activities of international organizations in the field of information and communication

International organizations in the system of international information relations. Classification, areas of information policy and program activities of international organizations. Activities of the UN specialized agencies in the field of information and communication. The political strategy of UNESCO in the field of information and communication. The new international information order (1980). Report by C. McBride "Many voices - one world". The new communication strategy of UNESCO (1985 - 1995rr.). World report on UNESCO data (1997-1998). Information Society for All (1996). UNESCO World Report on Communication (1997/98). Strategy for Knowledge Societies (2001). World UNESCO report on Information and Communication (1999/2000). Information support of visits. Classification and structure of information analysis and position papers for the visit. Information "wave" for the media. Media monitoring results of the visit. Information and analytical institutions in international relations. Classification, structure and working methods. Information and analytical products and services. The impact of information and analytical institutions for making foreign policy decisions.

Topic 9. Technology of network diplomacy

The concept of virtual diplomacy. International cooperation in the global network Internet. Classification and structure of the Web - websites of foreign ministries. Technology of network diplomacy. The impact of global media on the system of international relations. The activity of the masses - the media in foreign policy. Forms and means of information campaigns of foreign ministries. Technology of media diplomacy.

Topic 10. Technology of image diplomacy

Concept of image diplomacy. The activity of PR-departments of foreign ministries. Technologies and applications of development and maintenance of image in the international information space. The concept of state and foreign branding. Applications of state and foreign branding in the world. Technology of development and promotion of the brand in the state system of international relations. International public communication: classification, structure and specificity. Technologies of public diplomacy. The impact of public diplomacy in international relations.
