ATTRACTING FOREIGN INVESTMENTS: THE PATH TO RECOVERY AND DEVELOPMENT OF UKRAINE'S WOOD PROCESSING INDUSTRY

Ukraine's wood processing industry plays a significant role in the country's economic development and ensures sustainable growth. It contributes to job creation, the production of competitive goods, and the export of products. The State Forest Special Fund faces the challenge of raising necessary funds and restoring forest enterprises in the east and south, many of which have been almost completely destroyed [2]. This requires the implementation of various measures, such as establishing seed breeding centers, modernizing technical capabilities for selective logging, introducing digital technologies, and implementing various programs and projects.

To restore the wood processing industry and compensate for the incurred losses, it is essential to attract foreign investments. The Government of Ukraine actively collaborates with international donors to obtain financial support and technical assistance. The establishment of a

robust forest management company and attracting significant investments can be a step towards the industry's swift recovery.

One of the government's initiatives to attract foreign investments is the creation of the Advantage Ukraine platform, which was presented on September 6, 2022. Within this platform, ten priority sectors for investment in Ukraine have been identified, including the wood processing and furniture industry [3].

Ukraine, located in the geographical center of Europe, has a significant resource base for the development of the furniture and wood processing industry. Additionally, Ukrainian enterprises have the advantage of a free trade agreement with the EU, which contributes to increased exports to European markets.

The wood processing and furniture industry align with Ukraine's strategic development goals, as they are sectors with great growth potential and offer significant advantages for investors. It is important to note that the furniture and wood processing industry has substantial potential for development in Ukraine. According to estimates, the investment potential in these sectors exceeds \$5 billion [3].

To attract investors, the Government of Ukraine is creating favorable conditions, such as simplifying the tax system, utilizing financial instruments, and developing investment programs [3; 4]. These efforts incentivize foreign companies to invest in Ukraine's furniture and wood processing industry and generate profits from their investments.

The implementation of innovative technologies, such as the use of recycled materials, waste processing, and production process optimization, can help minimize losses and environmental pollution. Moreover, it will enhance production efficiency and reduce costs.

The use of recycled materials, waste processing, and process optimization enable the industry to reduce its negative environmental impact, lower costs, and ensure long-term sustainability.
